



## Monthly TIP on Meaningful Use CHPL Website- Certification ID

### What is CHPL?

The authoritative and comprehensive listing of Health IT certified through the ONC Health IT Certification Program.

### What is a Certification ID?

The certification authorized by the ONC certifying the EHR and EHR Modules are compliant with the standards, implementation specifications, and meet the definition of “certified EHR technology.”

### Obtaining your unique ONC EHR Certification ID.

#### Step 1

- Go to the CHPL website <https://chpl.healthit.gov/#/search>



#### Step 2

- Following the instructions on the site, search for the certified EHR products. There are many ways to search, but one option is by the search bar on the home screen.



### Step 3


- When the EHR product(s) is found, select the link on its row labeled “+CertID.” This icon will be yellow.

### Step 4

- Once the +Cert ID icon is selected this pop up box will appear.



### Step 5

- Select “Get 2014 EHR Certification ID.” Another pop up box where you can obtain your CERT ID will appear.





## Step 6

- Download the PDF and print to retain for your records.

## Step 7

- If you have more than one EHR product or version that you are using, select the "+CERT ID" icon for each product/version. A pop up box will appear. Select "Get CERT ID."





### Common Errors:

- Make sure that you search and select the correct EHR product and version to match what you are currently using.
- Using the CERT ID from the previous year.

### Best Practices:

- Make sure that you search and select the correct EHR product and version to match what you are currently using.
- Download the PDF, Print and save the CERT ID for your records along with other documents to retain.
- Contact your vendor to obtain the correct product versions and to confirm whether or not you are using multiple products.
- Any system upgrade can cause the CERT ID to change. Obtain the most recent CERT ID prior to attestation.
